Learn how to create a basic budget, find where your spending leaks are and learn to identify your “needs” versus your “wants”.

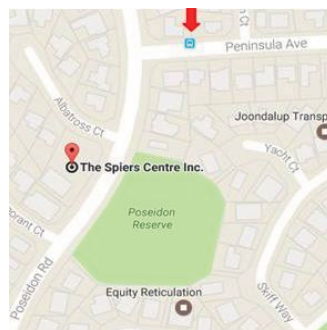
